As a result, our re-branding of the Phraselator® P2 required that we define a visual and functional language that would be at-home in a warfighter's pack: easy to operate while wearing gloves, designed to take a beating, and reliable under fire.

Voxtec's SQU.ID® SQ.200 hands-free, eyesfree device required a refinement of the Voxtec brand language that reflected how it is used: designed to be securely worn with a MOLLEcompatible holster, the look and feel needed to subtly project reliability and ruggedness while allowing users to focus attention on their tasks, not their equipment.

The next generation Phraselator® P3 updates the look and feel of the P2 while taking advantage of improvements in technology and reductions in component sizes. We evolved an interface that is still easy to use while wearing gloves, but migrated to a cast aluminum enclosure that beefed-up the device's ruggedness and incorporated visible fasteners and elastomeric details to reemphasize the reliability of the Voxtec brand.
