

Product Forecasting

To keep manufacturing costs down, we limited secondary operations (such as welded tabs on the radiused back cover edges) that may have improved aesthetics marginally but would have grown

the budget. After collecting budgetary quotes from a number of sheet metal contract manufacturers, we followed-up with ImageXpert's chosen vendor to make sure that our JetXpert design was logically executed, appropriately elegant, and easy to manufacture and assemble. We then made final refinements to the design that best aligned with the selected contract manufacturer's internal capabilities, and we supplied a complete 2D and 3D documentation package to the sheet metal house while arranging for our graphic design partner to supply artwork for the back and face plates. Not bad for a very aggressive timeline!
