

IP RATING GUIDE

IP (Ingress Protection) ratings are used to define the degree of protection against the intrusion of solid objets and water into enclosures. A number replaced by an X indicates that there is no specified rating for that protection.

The first digit indicates the degree of intrusion from solids and dust. The second digit indicates the degree of protection from water intrusion.

1	> 50mm	Protection from solid objets, such as a hand	1	Dripping Water	Protection from vertical falling drops of water, limited ingress permitted

3	> 2.5mm	Protection from smaller objets, such as tools	3	Spraying Water	Protection from sprays of water at any angle up to 60° from vertical, limited ingress permitted
4	> 1mm	Protection from very small objets, such as screws, wires, insects	4	Splashing Water	Protection from water splashes from any direction, limited ingress permitted
5	Dust Resistant	Limited ingress of dust permitted that does not interfere with operability	5	Low Pressure Water Jets	Protection from jets of water from any direction, limited ingress permitted
6	Dust Tight	No ingress of dust permitted	6	High Pressure Water Jets	Protection from strong jets of water from any direction, limited ingress permitted
